We have been selected by the Minnesota Vikings and Pacer to have a special presentation for our students with Viktor, the Viking's official mascot. Viktor's Quest to STOP Bullying assembly is an interactive presentation that features Viktor, an emcee, and call-in guests, such as Vikings players and cheerleaders. The presentation will reinforce student learning about bullying at Deephaven.
