Booster Store:

- New Spring posters are up
- Tuesday, April 2nd the store will be closed due to ACT testing and Early Release
 - o Will advertise that on social media
 - \circ Main door and West door attendants will be notified that the store is closed

- 20% off in May
 - Will have a special 20% off the week prior for Club Members
- Special hours in May and June
- Continue to put store information on Excelsior Chamber monthly emails
- Down about \$5,000 from last year sales but still feel secure in sales
- Store being open for German exchange dinner was a success
- All invoices are in
- Christine has put \$45,000 in for hold backs
 - Still have two vendor meetings remaining
 - Looking into pushing payment into August
